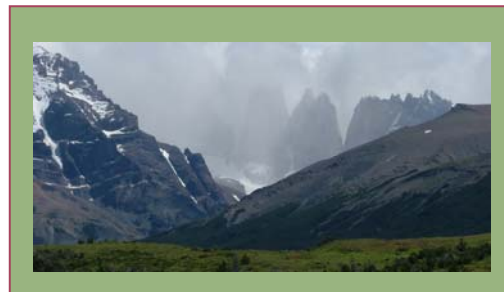


South America – A New Frontier
